## BN9 poll Terms and conditions

Creative Newhaven

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By entering the competition voters hereby agree to be bound by these rules as amended from time to time, and by any competition instructions.

It is the responsibility of voters to keep themselves informed as to any updates of these rules, and they acknowledge that any failure to comply with these rules could lead to their disqualification without reasons being given or opportunity for challenge.

1.1 The general principle is fairness: entries or votes should be made or cast fairly. If, in the opinion of Creative Newhaven this principle has been flouted, they can declare any entries or votes invalid, void the competition, change the competition instructions, or adjust the entries or the voting to achieve fairness, as they think fit. The competition instructions may carry a specific indication, but in the absence of such an indication, only one entry/ vote per entrant) will be permitted.

1.2 The entrant is entitled to vote once for each contestant in each poll. Any multiple votes from the same person will not be counted.

2. Anyone is entitled to vote once apart from the following exceptions:

2.1 Anybody that does not live in the BN9 0 or BN9 9 postcodes

2.2 Members of The Creative Newhaven Group

3.1 Entries must be made in accordance with the competition instructions. They are invalid if they are received any later than the specified closing time (which shall be London date and time).

3.2 The competition will open at 12 noon on Tuesday 21 June 2022 and close at 5pm on Tuesday 5 July 2022 any votes cast after this time and date will not be counted.

3.3 Votes cast online will be combined with those cast on paper to reach the final result

4.1 The winners will be chosen in accordance with the competition instructions.

5.1 There will be no cash or other alternative to the prize offered and prizes are not transferable.

6.1 The Creative Newhaven Group will not be liable for any circumstances beyond its reasonable control that prevent the competition being fulfilled, a winner or winners being chosen, or any prize being taken up or fully enjoyed by a winner.

7.1 The Creative Newhaven Working excludes liability to the extent permitted by law for any cost, claims or losses howsoever caused that arise by reason of any person's entry into a competition or the award, or non-award, to them of a prize.

8.1 Entrants will be asked for their email address before registering their vote which is voluntarily given.

8.2 If entrants supply an email address it will be used to determine one winner of a prize (two tickets to the vote winning show and a £25 Sidings Bistro voucher). The Creative Newhaven Working Group will never share entrants contact information with any organisation unless authorised to do so by the entrant.
